





There has been an increase in the number of incidents about doctors getting attacked by patients being reported in the country. Keeping this in mind, a unique effort has started where special lessons are devised to teach young doctors on how to communicate with patients.

A special workshop was organised at Sassoon Hospital and B | Medical College, Pune on Friday, 22 September to teach students communication skills on how to deal patients.

This was a part of the state government's program to teach medical students effective ways of communication. The state government is in coalition with the 'Origin Foundation', Thane has taken an initiative where such programs would be arranged in all the medical colleges in state.

Mumbai's JJ Hospital and KEM Hospital have already arranged such programs.

Dr Sandeep Mane, founder president of 'Origin Foundation', who is voluntarily delivering these lectures to students, said, "Relationship between doctors and patients have unfortunately deteriorated and we need to start rebuilding this. Now, patients have become intelligent, they read up on Google and they want good services. Doctors should be transparent with their patients and should not hold back any facts."

"In the workshop we create scenarios and asked doctors to react to a particular situation. Our education system focuses on knowledge and does not give these skills to our future doctors. But these young students want to learn them all and I am receiving a positive response from them," he added.

Dr Ajay Chandanwale, dean of B J Medical College, said, "We need to understand the western theory for doctor-patient relationship and should also incorporate it in our syllabus according to our needs. This will certainly benefit our students."

Medicos to be trained in communication

Aurangabad: Often heated arguments between doctors and their patients' relatives take violent turns and the medical practitioners are attacked. Taking a serious note of the issue, the health department decided to train doctors in communication skills.

Minister for medical education Girish Mahajan has approved a state-wide movement 'Susanwaad Abhiyaan' to train and
polish soft skills of medical professionals.

A Thane-based social organisation Origin Foundation is
facilitating the movement. Hospitals across the state have witnessed around 60 cases of attacks on doctors by their patients kin in the past two years.
Doctor groups such as The
Maharashtra Association of Resident Doctors (MARD) and Indian Medical Association (IMA)
have expressed dissent over the
incidents and the security management at government and
private hospitals have been made stricter. Yet the incidents keeprecurring.

Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) was assaulted by an HIV positive patients' kin after he died on November 12. After this incident the GMCH hosted a four-hour workshop at Mahatma Gandhi auditorium on Saturday under the Susanwaad project.

The head of GMCH's medical unit Sayeda Afroz said, "Origin Foundation's Sandeep Mane conducted eight sessions at the workshop which was attended by 250 people. The workshop was attended by 100 resident doctors, students and interns. It helped them understand how bad news such as cancer or declaring the patient dead should be broken down to the patients' relatives, to avoid conflict."

Senior resident doctor at GMCH Pranay Jambhulkar said, "The role-play method in the workshop guided us on how to deal with day-to-day things. They pointed out the mistakes made by taking real life examples."

The GMCH dean asked the audience to keep the patient and kin informed about the treatment.
